As your child enters school, we would like to offer a few tips to help you navigate the system. We know it can be overwhelming at first, but remember we are here to help.

To Do:

6. Contact HCPSS’ Office of Early Intervention for information about the Collaborative Funding Agreement which provides limited reimbursement to families who have established in-home Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) programs for the students from birth to kindergarten. Call 410-313-7017 or 410-313-7161.
7. Register your child on the Maryland Autism Waiver list, right away. Call Maryland State Department of Education at 410-767-1446.
8. Register your child with the Developmental Disabilities Administration: [www.dda.dhmdh.maryland.gov](http://www.dda.dhmdh.maryland.gov). Start at the “How to Apply” tab.
9. Register your address in the Howard County Police and Fire and Rescue Department’s 911 Address Flagging program. This provides first responders with key information specific to your child in the event of an emergency.
